

## Conflict of Interest: Ad Hoc Event/Gig Disclosure

The Governmental Conduct Act (GCA) states public officers (i.e., Music Commissioners) remain qualified to engage in an official act provided the financial benefit to the officer is proportionately less than the benefit to the public.

The Attorney General's Office has advised creation of a disclosure form which will alert the Commission of potential conflicts with special events and gigs arising on an ad hoc basis. All Commissioners shall complete and sign the form below in the event a possible/perceived conflict of interest should arise. The Executive Committee will review the below information and determine if there is a conflict of interest. The completed form will be kept on file in the Music Commission office and with the Commission's Assistant Attorney General.
